ABOUT THE ISLIP ART MUSEUM

The Islip Art Museum is Long Island's center for contemporary art. Each year, the Museum presents at least five exhibitions annually. The Carriage House at the Islip Art Museum is the leading center for experimental art on Long Island. Each year, the Carriage House presents two Project Space exhibitions and a spring Carriage House Studio Residency exhibit.

The Islip Art Museum does not present one person shows. Exhibitions are primarily organized to reflect themes and concepts which convey trends and concerns in the contemporary art world.

The Museum's mission is to facilitate the creation of new art by emerging artists. The Museum is particularly interested in work that addresses recent aesthetic strategies, cultural and theoretical concerns, and work that is experimental in nature.

The Islip Art Museum welcomes opportunities to review the work of all artists. The Museum will not review portfolios or artist's work in person.

The enclosed guidelines are designed to help you submit your work to our staff.

SUBMITTING WORK FOR CONSIDERATION TO THE ISLIP ART MUSEUM

The following must be submitted for the curators to consider your work:

1. Up to 20 JPEG images of recent and past work on CD. You may also include color copies, laser prints and announcement cards from previous exhibitions (photocopies acceptable - originals will not be returned) JPEG file name should indicate artist name and numerical reference. Format CD for PC or Mac. JPEG file 1 image per file, 1240 x 1240, RGB color, no larger than 4 mbs each image.

2. A work sample inventory list with specifications of each image cross referenced to the images on the CD. This list can be JPEG, PDF or Word document (digital included on CD with work or hard copy). This list will indicate detailed information about each piece (artist name, title of work, dimensions, medium, date).

3. In the case of video/performance/other please submit up to two works on one dvd and/or cd and label with artist name, title of work and date.

4. A recent resume (PDF or Word) included on artist CD or hard copy submitted with CD.

5. Artist statement specific to work submitted.

Do not submit video stills, trailers or promotional pieces.
